Notes on Classes at Hood College

- 1) Keep in mind that there isn't a ton of deck space around the pool. There is a lobby area that you can use for setting up gear, but be very very careful having the students go down the stairs with their gear, it would be very easy for someone to slip especially if the floors get wet.
- 2) All students need to park out on Rosemont, and the truck needs to be put there too, unless specifically told otherwise by the Aquatics staff. On occasion they have allowed us to stay parked on campus but that is an exception, not the rule.
- 3) Our assigned classroom is the third floor classroom in the Gambrill Gymnasium building. From time to time the University has taken this room for events—there is another room overlooking the pool, which can also be used. If that room isn't available, there is a room behind the gymnasium that can be used. Not having the third floor room is a rarity. If the door is locked call 301-663-3131, get an operator and ask to get the door opened for class.
- 4) Thunder policy is everybody must be off the deck 30 minutes from the last thunder heard. Normally we will go into the lounge that overlooks the pool, unless told otherwise by the guard. If we need makeup time, we will arrange it on a case by case basis with the guard and the Aquatics Director, but it may require us to stay later than our anticipated 5:00pm finish time.
